

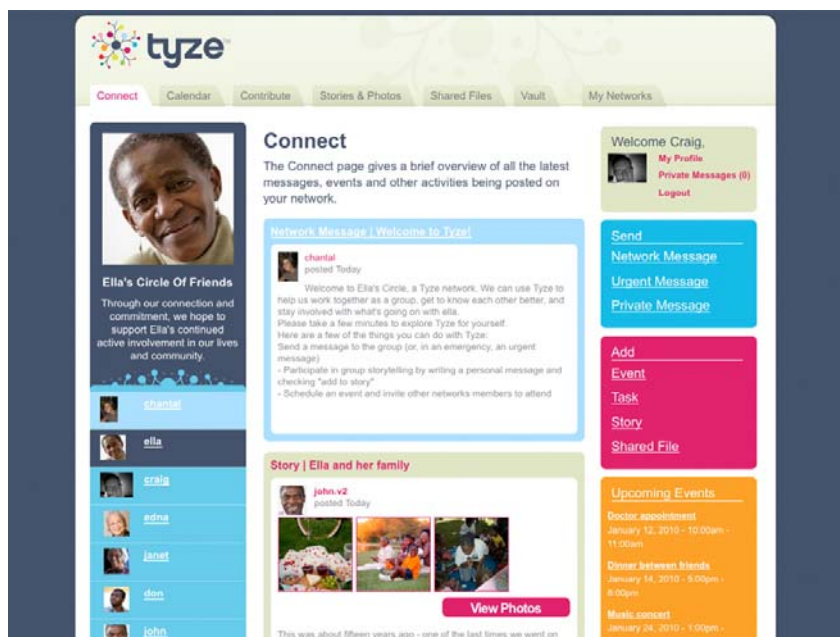
# Join Us - Learn About Online Social Networking with a Purpose At the San Francisco Public Library!
